



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY, INDONESIA
AND**

KERMANSHAH UNIVERSITY OF MEDICAL SCIENCES, IRAN

Both parties **Hasanuddin University (UNHAS)** (the first party), at Jl. Perintis Kemerdekaan Km.10 Tamalanrea, Makassar, Sulawesi Selatan, Indonesia and **Kermanshah University of Medical Sciences (KUMS)** (the second party), headquartering at International Affairs, Shahid Beheshti Boulevard, Kermanshah, Iran have agreed upon the general terms of the present agreement of this **Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)**, in accordance with a mutual desire for cooperation and collaboration aimed at improving, strengthening and promoting relations between the two respective universities and exchanging the experiences regarding the scientific and research activities, national capabilities, solidarity for our beloved country progress and promoting the professional scientific ranking of our students, setting programs that fulfill the needs of community and develop it, and firming up the state development plan of comprehensive sustainability that never violates applicable legislation in each country. Therefore, both parties agreed on the followings:

Article 1: Cooperation Fields

Both universities hereby express their intention to promote cooperation between academic members, students and research groups and work together to implement the hereunder cooperative fields:

A) Education

- 1.1 Exchanging lecturers to teach the required subjects in different fields.
- 1.2 Facilitating the postgraduates (Master or PhD.) admission for both parties.
- 1.3 Setting a clear strategy for Post-Doctorate, Specialty, and Subspecialty programs for the counterparts' departments in both universities, and it must not contradict the valid and applicable legislations.
- 1.4 Establishing joint degree programs between interested departments of both parties.
- 1.5 Exchanging scientific consultations considering curricula and academic syllabuses in joint programs.
- 1.6 Offering non-degree programs
- 1.7 Creating a data base for two parties' academic staff.





B) Research

- 1.8 Benefiting from the laboratories in two universities by making mutual scientific research, that must not affect the current tests by setting a proper mechanism and cooperation between both parties.
- 1.9 Contributing to both parties' researchers in consultation prospects and holding training courses.
- 1.10 Cooperating in training scientific fields and modern scientific technologies in common specializations for both parties.
- 1.11 Promoting and encouraging activities of joint research in fields of common interest that may serve the scientific fields without violating the applicable disciplines.
- 1.12 Contributing in scientific conferences and symposiums held by two parties.
- 1.13 Preparing proper circumstances to print and publish scientific research journals.
- 1.14 Identifying two universities' technologies, and getting benefit from technical, engineering and architectural services needed by two parties.
- 1.15 Building a study network and joint research programs among two parties.
- 1.16 Cooperating in using and developing the scientific information resources between two parties.

C) Medical Diagnoses and Treatment

- 1.17 Providing medical and treatment services for patients.
- 1.18 Mutual cooperation in the field of health tourism development and accepting patients of medical centers of Iraq in the field of inpatient and outpatient services.

Article 2: Both parties' commitments

Both parties commit the hereunder:

- 2.1 Assembling a joint team consisting of two parties' academic staff directly supervised by the Vice Chancellor for Education and the heads of related departments to implement and follow up the programs' mechanism. A routine meeting for every six months shall be held to negotiate, execute and follow up the provisions of this MOU by two parties to guarantee the maximum advantage and achievement.
- 2.2 Assigning an official touchpoint (coordinator) for each party who shall be among the members of the committee mentioned in 2.1. to implement this MOU.
- 2.3 Creating an International Journal including three languages: English, Arabic language and Persian languages that specializes in common and comparative subjects among the two countries in different fields of medical sciences. The editors of this Journal shall be from both parties.
- 2.4 Establishing a Study Center (Indonesian - Iranian center) in the both universities.
- 2.5 Establishing reciprocal links on the official websites of two universities.





Article 3: Program's Period

This agreement is written and signed in English in two copies. The present agreement will come into force as soon as it has been signed by the authorized representatives of the two universities and will remain in force for a four-year period from the date of execution and may be renewed for an additional four-years upon mutual written consent. The agreement may be terminated by the authorized official representative of either university by written notice. Such notice must be given at least three months before it becomes effective. Such termination shall not affect the completion of any activity underway at the time or the rights of individuals exchanged under this agreement, prior to the notice of termination.

Article 4: Financial commitment

- 4.1 The Financial and Administrative issues shall be agreed on through the direct communication between the two parties, and the details must be determined in annexes that include detailed work items. These annexes must include costs, time schedule and the predicted output to implement the agreed plans. The annex is considered the part of the MOU and will be valid according to the same procedures that already stipulated in the Article 3.
- 4.2 This MOU is not related to any financial commitment among the two parties.

Article 5: Disagreements

The risen conflicts that resulted from the current MOU's interpretation and implementation can be solved directly among two parties; otherwise, the conflict can be solved through a coordination committee assembled for that reason. In case, the mentioned committee cannot solve the conflict, the proper solution will be to terminate this MOU.

Article 6: Reforms

Any changes, amendments, reconsidering, deleting or adding new provisions to this MOU is forbidden, unless both parties agree through a written agreement within a certain period, then amendment can be inserted following the same procedures that mentioned in the Article 3.

Article 7: Confidentiality

Each party has the right of intellectual property's rights for its staff, students and agents according to this MOU, and each party can award the other party a permission of use that cannot be cancelled for the purpose of teaching and research for that party. Also, two parties have agreed that the mutual information can be used only for the determined purposes without transferring this information to a third party prior to a written approval from the other party.
